VOTE411.org is a “one-stop-shop” providing simple tools to help Mobile voters navigate the voting process for current elections. It contains candidate information, voter registration tools, polling place locations, information about the new voter photo ID requirement and other helpful Election Day (Tuesday, November 4) information.
